Day-1 (12th August 2025): Orientation program

Day -2 (13th August 2025): Lecture on "Say yes to ragging free campus"

The lecture was given by **Dr. Girish Nagarale, Professor, Dept. of Periodontics** on the topic of **'Say yes to ragging free campus'.** He addressed the students about the origin and menace of ragging in India and also explained the legal consequences of involvement in such activities. He also reiterated that anyone who is actively or passively, or is a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished. He also addressed that drug consumption makes students mentally and physically weak. It also attracts various diseases and requested all the students should stay away from drug abuse. He also created awareness on how the Disha App can be used in times of danger to women across the state and asked every women and girl to download the Disha App and ragging helpline services.
