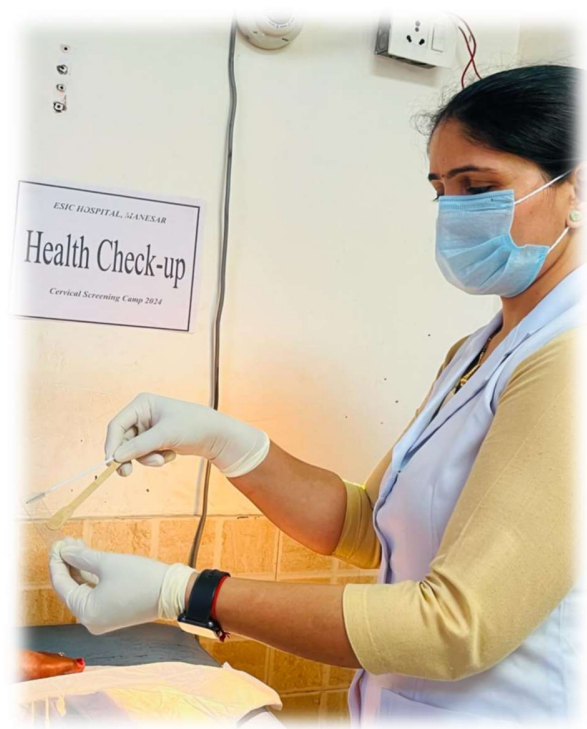

SYMPTOMS

POSTCOITAL BLEEDING
BLEEDING OR SPOTTING IN B/W PERIODS
WATERY, BLOOD-TINGED VAGINAL DISCHARGE
MENSTRUAL PERIODS BECOME HEAVIER OR LONGER

HOW DO YOU SCREEN FOR CERVICAL C_x

- 21-29 YEARS OLD - PAP TEST EVERY 3 YEARS
- 30-65 YEARS OLD - PAP TEST + HPV TESTING EVERY 5 YEARS {CO-TESTING}

PREVENTION

GET THE HPV VACCINE

- RECOMMENDED FOR GIRLS & BOYS AT AGE 11-12
- CAN BE GIVEN TO ADULTS AGES 26-45
- PROTECTS AGAINST MOST DANGEROUS TYPES & GENTAL WARTS
